
About the MCAT Exam



The MCAT Exam

Medical College Admission Test (MCAT)


- Standardized, multiple-choice
- Required by almost all U.S. & many Canadian medical schools
- Assesses:
 - Problem solving and reasoning
 - Critical thinking
 - Knowledge of scientific concepts







4 Skills Demonstrated

- Knowledge of Scientific Principles
- Scientific Reasoning and Problem-Solving
- Reasoning about the Design and Execution of Research
- Data-Based Statistical Reasoning

Critical Analysis and Reasoning Skills



- Tests reasoning & comprehension
- Passages from humanities & social science disciplines:
 - Philosophy
 - Ethics
 - Population health
 - Studies of diverse cultures

No disciplinary knowledge required

MCAT Scores



MCAT score report

- Scores are received 30-35 days after test day
- Accessed through the MCAT Score Reporting System
- Can submit application before taking the exam by indicating test date in AMCAS

■ When do they want to apply to medical school?

■ Will they want to leave the option for retesting?

Do they understand and feel comfortable with the content tested?



Applying for AAMC Fee Assistance

The AAMC's Fee Assistance Program helps those with financial need. It defrays the cost of preparing for and taking the MCAT exam and applying to medical school

Deadlines

- Application is open now.
- Typically opens in February and closes in December.

Eligibility

- Open to everyone with a U.S.-based address can apply.
- Family household income must be 400 percent or less than the 2022 national poverty level for that family size.

Important to Know!

- Parental information required for students under age 26
- Benefits are not retroactive. Apply at least 10 days in advance of when a student plans to use the benefits
- Benefits are good from date of approval and expire the next calendar on Dec. 31




Calendar Year 2023





Applying for AAMC Fee Assistance



Benefits

- Reduced MCAT registration fees
- Access to all 15 online AAMC MCAT Official Prep Products
- Stipend for updated evaluation for MCAT accommodations
- AMCAS application submission fee waiver (up to 20 schools)
- Complimentary access to the Medical School Admission Requirements (MSAR) website
- Registration is free for PREview



Testing with Accommodations

The AAMC is committed to providing all individuals with an opportunity to demonstrate their proficiency on the MCAT exam, including ensuring access to persons with disabilities

- About 1.5% test with accommodations
- Commonly provided accommodations include:
 - Extra testing time
 - Extra break time
 - Separate testing rooms
- MCAT Accommodations Online System (MAO)
 - Allows examinees to submit applications and documentation online for secure and efficient processing
 - Stores all decision letters for easy access in the future



Registration is open for all dates in 2023

We host an annual webinar at the start of each testing year.

Important to Know

- Last testing date in 2023 is September 10.
- Students can't reschedule into the next testing year.
- Rescheduling and cancellation fees apply.

MCAT Scheduling Tips for Your Students

- Available Appointment Notification Request
 - Helps examinees secure preferred test date and location if it becomes available
 - Can have up to 5 notification requests
- When possible, reschedule/cancel an exam early
 - Helps students who are on the notification lists secure exam appointments

In 2022, over 20% of appointments were made through "Notify Me."






Considerations for retaking the MCAT exam



There are testing limits

- 1 year Up to 3 attempts in a testing year
- 2 years Up to 4 attempts over 2 consecutive years
- Lifetime Up to 7 attempts in a lifetime



How well do students do when they retest?

- 10% of students retest in a single year and 38% of examinees retest overall
- Generally, examinees increase 2-4 points
- Still variability in scores on retake attempts
