2025 Application Dates

Application Deadlines

- Application must be submitted by 11:59 p.m. ET on the deadline date
- Transcripts must be received by the AMCAS program within 14 calendar days of the application deadline date (or the next business day if the deadline date falls on a weekend or holiday)
- <u>Early Decision Program</u> applicants all transcripts must be received by Friday, Aug. 1st, 2025

Transcript Policy Information for the 2026 AMCAS Application Cycle

- 1. Electronically via secure file transfer process (SFTP) from <u>Parchment</u>, <u>National Student Clearinghouse</u> (NSC) or <u>Certree</u>
 - Parchment can send both emailed and eTranscripts; NSC can only send eTranscripts via Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP); Certree can only send eTranscripts via SFTP.

2. Emailed directly from the Registrar Office

- If your school does not use Parchment, NSC or Certree, you are eligible to email transcripts. Please contact us at etranscripts@aamc.org to begin the approval process.
- If you were approved to email transcripts last year, you will not need to complete this process a second time.

3. Paper Transcripts via USPS, UPS, FedEx, or DHL

- If applicants have questions regarding our transcript policies, they can <u>send a message</u> to the AAMC Support Center or call 202-828-0600
- The AMCAS program will only investigate a missing transcript if it was sent via expedited mail service (Priority Mail, FedEx, UPS, DHL) and we are provided with the tracking number.

Transcript Processing & Timelines

- If you use postal mail, please allow 14 days from the post date for receipt.
 - Once received, the transcript may take an additional 10-15 days to process.
 - eTranscripts are preferred to avoid a lengthy postal process.
- Processing timelines are published daily on <u>our website</u>.

As of December 4 AMCAS is:

Marking transcripts as "Received" that were delivered on or before:

Paper (mailed) - December 3

Parchment - December 3

National Student Clearinghouse – **December 4**

Certree - December 4


Processing applications that reached "Ready for Review" on **December 3.**

Impact on AMCAS Application

How and when transcripts are received, matters.



Important Information

- AY2026 will open on May 1, 2025.
- The AMCAS program does not advise applicants on making application related decisions.
- Applicants can submit their application before letters and transcripts are received; however, <u>all official transcripts must</u> <u>be received</u> before verification is started.
- Transcripts must be received by the AMCAS program within 14 calendar days after the application deadline.
- Peak Application: June to September. Applications received during this time may take up to six weeks to process.



AMCAS Application Grading System



AMCAS Grading System Request

At the beginning of each calendar year, the AMCAS program sends an email request for information to each of the institutions within the AMCAS system to verify their current grading system information.

Dear Registrar,

You play a vital role in assisting your students and alumni attain their goal of attending medical school. We are writing to request your updates to our American Medical College Application Service® (AMCAS®) college list. Having the correct information in our system helps the AMCAS program verify applications properly, ensures that your students and alumni are represented accurately to their prospective medical schools, and limits the frequency with which your students and alumni contact your office.

If any changes were made to your institution's calendar (e.g., from semester calendar to quarter calendar), grading system, credit system, special programs, back of transcript, school name, and/or contact information since March 2024, we ask that you include the updated documents in your email response.

Reply YES – changes have been made. Please attach the updated information (back of official transcript, transcript key, etc.)

Reply NO - no changes have been made. AMCAS can keep the current information on file

The AMCAS program will not make changes or add Main/Special Programs (Graduate, Law, Pharmacy, etc.) after the opening of the AMCAS application cycle in May 2025.

Documentation must be submitted via email by March 13, 2025. If we do not receive a response, the AMCAS program will keep the current information on file. Information received after the deadline will be saved and updated in the next application cycle.

If this is your first time submitting calendar, grading system, and/or credit system information to the AMCAS program, contact our verification staff at registrarletters@aamc.org for detailed instructions. We encourage you to reach out if you have any questions regarding your school's information. Registrars should not send official transcripts to this email. Please review the AMCAS for Registrars [click email aamc.org] website for information on how to send official transcripts during our application cycle.

Please note, for the upcoming 2026 application cycle, the AMCAS program will only accept transcripts sent by mail, electronically from approved vendors, or via secure email from approved school senders. We will not accept transcripts via fax or from schools that have not been pre-approved to send transcripts by email.

AMCAS Grade Conversion

AMCAS converts most standard college and institution transcript grades to AMCAS grades based on conversion information provided by colleges and institutions.

Document Processing and Transcripts



What transcripts are required for AMCAS program Applicants?

One official transcript is required from each U.S., U.S. territorial, or Canadian postsecondary institution at which coursework was attempted, regardless of whether credit was earned.



AMCAS Transcript Requests

Correspondence & Home Study Programs

Courses that did not count towards a degree (earned or transferred)

Attempted college level courses taken while in High School

Attempted/Completed college level courses, even if transferred

Attempted coursework at extension programs.

All colleges where the applicant was registered... even if no credit was earned.

Military Education

American Colleges overseas

Transcript Request Process



Mailed transcripts should include the AMCAS Pre-barcoded Transcript Request Form to help us match the transcript(s) to the correct application and application year.


What happens when a transcript is received by the AMCAS Service?





Transcript Processing – Authentication Process

The AMCAS program is responsible for verifying the authenticity of each transcript received.



This transcript is not official without the signature of the registrar.

Transcript Processing – Indexing Process

Transcript indexing is the process of recording the receipt date and status of a transcript.

Applicants receive automatic emails notifying them of the transcript receipt.





Transcript Processing – Scanning Process

Scanning transcripts received in support of AMCAS application creates images for paperless processing.

Transcripts receive a barcode during the indexing process so that a digital image may be created of the document.





Electronic Transcripts



E-Transcripts:

- The AMCAS program only accepts PDF eTranscripts from approved senders – National Student Clearinghouse, Parchment, Certree
 - These vendors may only submit transcripts to AMCAS via secure file transfer process (SFTP)

Emailed Transcripts:

- The AMCAS program will accept emailed transcripts from approved registrar senders
 - Contact us at <u>etranscripts@aamc.org</u> to begin the approval process
