MPH Tuition Policy:

The MPH program requires a total of 48 credit hours. Twelve credits can be shared between the MD and the MPH which results in a 25% reduction in total tuition cost for the MPH. Joint degree students are charged per credit according to current tuition rates for the Public Health degree program.
